About the Workshop:

This is a workshop about the stories of those who have committed suicide. What were the "thoughts" and "feelings" of the individuals before their death? Why did they choose to say goodbye in this way? Were they trying to end "life" or "suffering"?

In managing crises, how do counsellors have self compassion and self care?

In her 30 years of counselling experience, Angela has dealt with the aftermath of dozens of suicide cases, visiting the families and schools of the deceased. We sincerely invite you to participate in this workshop to explore how the suicide survivors navigate their grief and reflect on life.
